## Cookies

We may sometimes use an Internet file called a cookie to store login or other information on your computer. A cookie is a small piece of information stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. Cookies are used to make the link between you and the information you have provided to the website, to identify users and personalise their visit by customising web pages for them. Most Websites automatically accept cookies although you do not have to. If you disable cookies from your browser, you may not be able to access certain features of our website.
